3. Product Description

ASH GROVE PRO® Precision Grout is an early high strength, nonshrink, nonmetallic portland cement material designed for high performance grouting.

4. Advantages/Benefits

ASH GROVE PRO® Precision Grout has several advantages and features including:

- High strength precision grouting
- · Non-corrosive, will not attack reinforcement
- Non-shrink, no loss of volume
- Non-metalic non-staining, grey color
- Meets ASTM C-1107 packaged dry, hydraulic cement (non-shrink)
- Meets Corps of Engineers specification CRD-C 621
- Plastic, flowable or fluid consistency
- Pumpable for easy placement in difficult and low clearance installations
- Super plasticized for improved strength

5. Preparation

Selection of the grout is to be done by the engineer. Remove all unsound concrete, grease, oil, paint, and any other foreign material that will inhibit

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performance. Prior to grout placement, all surfaces must be clean and saturated with water for 24 hours. Remove excess water before placing the grout. Provide air relief holes where necessary if grouting is beneath structural systems.

Suggestions in form work:

Wood form work or other absorbent forms should be coated with a form release oil to prevent grout adherence and excessive water absorption. Design form work to facilitate rapid, continuous and complete filling of the space to be grouted. Use methods that will enable the grout to flow by gravity between the surfaces and keep the grout in full contact with these surfaces until it has hardened.

6. Mixing Instructions

Add only clean water. The water quantities shown are approximate and may vary slightly with type of equipment and application conditions.

For optimum application and product performance, the mix temperature should be 60°F to 70°F at time of placement. This can be done when applying at temperature extremes by storing Multi-Purpose Grout bags at 60°F to 70°F, 12 to 24 hours prior to mixing. Addition of cold water (45°F) at high temperatures (90°F) or warm water (80°F) at low temperatures (50°F) will also aid in adjusting the mix temperature. Water demand and mix temperature must be determined using standard test methods for consistency and temperature measurement at the time of application.

Desired Grout Consistency

<u>Plastic (Trowel Consistency)</u>, 55 lbs. grout, approximately 1.10 gallon water (9.2 lbs.) will yield 0.51 cu. ft. with a unit weight of 126 lbs./cu. ft.

<u>Flowable (Pumping Consistency)</u>, 55 lbs. grout, approximately 1.12 gallon water will yield 0.52 cu. ft. with unit weight of 125 lbs./cu. ft.

Fluid (Pumpable Consistency), 55 lbs. grout, approximately 1.50 gallon water will yield 0.54 cu. ft. with a unit weight of 123 lbs./cu. ft.

Use a mixer large enough to permit continuous placement before any part of the grout has set.

7. Placement

Place the grout quickly. Rodding the grout lightly will help remove air bubbles. Avoid vibration which can cause bleeding and segregation. Shut down nearby machines.

8. Curing

Forms may be removed as soon as the grout is firm and cannot be penetrated by a pointed masonry trowel. Exposed shoulders can be left in place or trimmed. After the forms are removed, prevent evaporation by keeping the exposed surfaces wet for several hours. Protect from freezing for a minimum of 48 hours after placing.

Precision Grout can be left exposed under normal weathering conditions. For installations where acids and sulfates are present, a protective coating is required.

Cure per Portland Cement Association - <u>Design and</u> <u>Control of Concrete Mixes (EB001.12T)</u> and/or American Concrete Institute 308 - <u>Standard Practice</u> for Curing Concrete.

- DO NOT retemper.
- DO NOT add excessive amounts of water.
- DO NOT use vibrators in placing the grout.
- DO NOT add any other materials.
- DO NOT apply on substrates that are frozen or contain frost.
